ORAL METHOD for the DEAF







In the ORAL training of the hearing impaired, they are shown how each sound is produced thru mouth & tongue positioning, direct imitation of teacher's patterns, drawing of the speech profile, feeling the vibrating vocal or nasal sounds, transcribing visually hard words, hand analogy of mouth movements, endless speech drills and constant conversations to master the everyday language thru ONE-ON-ONE Speech Therapy classes. Mastery of all the sounds enables them to do endless speech drills [Nonsense SYLLABLE drills, WORD drills; PHASE drills; SENTENCE drills; QUESTION & ANSWER drills, poems, storytelling, news sharing, role playing, school contests & annual recitals] Also includes AUDITORY, RHYTHM Lip Reading & LANGUAGE Training.
